

Abstract submission

Guide for authors

The requested abstract structure will be as follows:

Abstract title (max 10 words)

Autor(s)/presenter(s)

Introduction (max 80 words)

Research objective/Aims (max 80 words)

Materials & Methods (max 80 words)

Results & discussion (max 100 words)

Conclusion (max 30 words)

Please read the submission rules before submitting an abstract.

- Abstracts must be submitted online via the website only. **Abstracts submitted by email will not be accepted.**
- Presentation Type: Abstracts may be submitted for a **Poster** or **Oral** presentation.
- Abstracts must be received by the announced deadline. Abstracts received after the deadline will not be considered.
- The same person may submit up to 3 abstracts regardless of presenting author.
- The same person may serve as the presenting author on up to 3 abstracts.
- Submission of an abstract acknowledges your acceptance for the abstract to be published in the official congress publications.
- The presenting author is required to ensure that all co-authors are aware of the content of the abstract and agree to its submission, before submitting the abstract.
- Presenting authors must be registered participants. Only abstracts of authors who have **paid** their registration fees will be scheduled for presentation and included in the publication. Excluding invited key note presenters.
- Abstracts must be submitted in English. All abstracts should be submitted and presented in clear English with accurate grammar and spelling of a quality suitable for publication. If you need help, please arrange for the review of your abstract by a colleague who is a native English speaker, by a university-specific publications office (or other similar facilities), or by a copy editor, prior to submission.

- Abstracts must be original and must not have been published or presented at any other meeting prior to this Annual Meeting of the ECSRHM.
- Disclosure of Conflicts of Interest: Abstract submitters will be required to disclose any conflict of interest in the submission form.
- All research presented must comply with international standards pertaining to animal welfare, ethics, and data protection.
- First author/presenting author must submit bibliography form upon presentation/poster acceptance.
